



MILL SHELLS – ELBURGON, KENYA



TRANSEAST SCOPE OF WORK

- Transeast to transport mills shells from Kilindini port to Elburgon, Kenya.
- Establish appropriate trailer configuration for loads in line with KENHA (Kenya National Highways Authority) legal requirements.
- Access all viable routes / site surveys and document. Where applicable bridge calculations, turning radiuses and stability calculations.
- Carry out risk analysis and document.
- Ensure daily tool box talks are carried out and documented.
- Receive shells from vessel via direct discharge in port.
- Apply abnormal permits with KENHA.
- Transeast workshop section to strip cradles and refabricate and adjust due to height restrictions.
- Transeast to manage convoys with own escorts.
- Client to arrange offloading at site.
